This four-year elective course provides students with essential training in drawing, painting, and visual composition. Through observation, imagination, and digital tools, students develop artistic techniques, creative thinking, and practical skills tailored to real-world applications.

The course nurtures both self-expression and professional development, encouraging cultural appreciation and preparing students for careers in visual arts and related industries.

What Students Will Learn

The curriculum progresses in complexity over the four years:

- Form I: Fundamentals of drawing and painting, artistic tools, ethical practices, and CAD basics.
- Form II: Composition skills using traditional and digital media, working from observation and imagination.
- Form III: Thematic artworks with increased complexity, figure drawing, and digital creation.

 Form IV: Advanced techniques in realism and conceptual art, preservation, marketing, and exhibition.

Students work with traditional materials (pencil, paint, charcoal) and digital platforms (Photoshop, Illustrator, Clip Studio Paint).

Assessment & Support

- 30% Continuous Assessment: Includes projects, portfolios, and classwork.
- 70% National Form IV Examination.
- Parents' Role: Support learning at home, encourage creativity, and follow progress closely
