Film & TV Production

Learn to tell powerful stories through the lens: Inspire, direct, and create

This four-year elective course focuses on the decorative, This four-year elective course equips students with the knowledge and practical skills to plan, shoot, and produce content for film and television. It introduces learners to visual storytelling, camera work, scriptwriting, directing, editing, and sound design.

The program empowers students to express ideas through media, understand production workflows, and develop teamwork and communication skills essential in the creative industry.

What Students Will Learn

Each year builds technical, creative, and collaborative skills:

- Form I: Introduction to storytelling, camera basics, shot types, production roles, and film safety.
- Form II: Scriptwriting, storyboarding, acting for camera, sound basics, and short scene production.
- Form III: Directing techniques, lighting, editing with video software, group short

film projects.

- Form IV: Full production cycles, pre/post-production planning, marketing and screening of films, and digital portfolios.

Students use tools such as video cameras, microphones, editing software (like DaVinci Resolve, Adobe Premiere, or CapCut), and basic lighting kits.

Assessment & Support

- 30% Continuous Assessment: Group projects, scriptwriting, filming, and post-production tasks.
- 70% Final National Examination (Form IV).
- Parents' Role: Encourage creativity, ensure access to digital tools where possible, and support student-led projects.

Career Opportunities

Graduates will be prepared for further studies or entry-level roles in the media and creative industries, including:

- Videographer, Camera Assistant
- Scriptwriter, Film Editor, Production Assistant Social Media Content Creator
